



**Invitation to the International  
Beetle Cabriolet Meeting in Biel/Bienne  
August 7th to 9th, 2026**

## *Dear Beetle Cabriolet Drivers,*

We are very pleased to invite you to our international Beetle Cabriolet Meeting from August 7th to 9th, 2026.

The meeting will take place in Biel/Bienne. This bilingual city is located near Bern, at the foot of the Jura mountains.

The planned program highlights are:

- Friday      Arrival, tour of Biel / Watch Museum
- Saturday    Drive through the Jura, evening entertainment
- Sunday     Visit to the Volkswrecks Museum

A flat rate will be charged for the entire weekend, which includes two nights in the hotel, meals (excluding drinks), and the entire program.

## Event Details

### Hotel

All participants will stay at the Courtyard by Marriott Hotel at Place de l'Esplanade in the center of Biel.

### Prices

Prices per person in Swiss Francs

Adult in double room: CHF 450.–

Children up to 6 years: approx. CHF 100.– (price on request)

Children 6 – 16 years: approx. CHF 200.– (price on request)

Single room for both nights: Surcharge CHF 130.–

Dogs in the hotel: CHF 25.– per night

The prices include the following services:

2 nights including garage parking, 2x breakfast, 2x dinner, 1x lunch, drives and entertainment. Drinks are not included.

Maximum 2 adults and 1 child per room. If there are more children, we will calculate the price individually.

### Registration

Registration is done using the registration form by March 31, 2026.

One registration is required per vehicle.

Invoices will be sent afterwards. Registration is only final once it has been confirmed and the amount has been paid.

The number of vehicles is limited to 90.

If this number is exceeded, a waiting list will be maintained.

### Vehicles

Eligible are VW Beetle Cabriolets built by Karmann or Hebmüller. The vehicles must be roadworthy.

### Arrival

Biel is located in the Swiss midlands, near Bern, and can be reached from Basel via the motorway in 75 minutes. A motorway vignette is required for using the motorway. However, during the event, we will not be driving on motorways.

## **Program**

Participants will receive the detailed, multilingual program with all details and times upon arrival. The Friday evening briefing is mandatory for drivers.

On Friday afternoon, the organizing team will welcome you from 2 p.m. at Place de l'Esplanade in the center of Biel. After registration, you can tour Biel or visit the Watch Museum.

In the evening, we will dine at the Biel Congress Center and hold the briefing.

Vehicles will be parked in the underground garage.

On Saturday, the drive through the Jura will take place. Participants will be divided into small groups and given a start time. The start will be at Place de l'Esplanade.

Various stops are planned during the drive. We will visit a cheese dairy and a chocolate factory. There will be coffee breaks and lunch. All of this is included in the participation fee.

Dinner will be at Brasserie Rotonde, followed by music and a bar.

On Sunday, we will drive to Val-de-Travers to the Volkswrecks Museum, where around 100 non-roadworthy VW Beetles and VW buses are on display.

The meeting will officially end there at 2 p.m.

## **Additional program**

Participants who do not wish to leave immediately can additionally book a late, good lunch at the Mines d'asphalte (ham cooked in asphalt) and a tour of the mine (limited places).
